Eyota Summer Recreation Information

Dates for City Hall Registration*

Wednesday, March 30 from 6:00-8:00pm Saturday, April 2 from 11:00-1:00pm

Maximum Family Fee - This year, a maximum family fee is available for families. You may sign up for as many activities as desired (WOW trips are an additional cost). Keep your child(ren) active and involved! Families living outside the city limits of Eyota will be charged an additional \$10 per child.

1 child = \$75 for Eyota residents; \$85 for outside Eyota city limit residents
2 children = \$100 for Eyota residents; \$120 for outside Eyota city limit residents
3 or more children = \$150 for Eyota residents; \$180 for outside Eyota city limit residents

Late Fees

- Any registration received after April 4, 2016 will be assessed a \$15 late fee, per family.
- If your registration is late you also need to contact Summer Rec Director Ryan Scheevel.

Refund Policy

- No refunds will be given after registration deadline unless an activity is cancelled due to not having enough participants, or in case of a family or medical emergency.
- If an activity is offered at registration is cancelled due to lack of enrollment, either a refund will be issued or the opportunity to participate in a different activity will be offered.

General Program Dates

- June 7th - July 29th
- Happy 4th of July! No activities July 1st - July 7th! Enjoy!
- Activities will resume on Monday, July 11th.

Activity Cancellation

- If there is a weather watch or warning - Tornado Watch, Tornado Warning, Severe Thunderstorm Watch, Severe Thunderstorm Warning, and/or Heat Index - all summer recreation activities will be cancelled. During a situation like this the safest place for your child to be is at your home.
- Cancellation of activities will be posted on the city website, city Facebook page, Summer Recreation Facebook page (Search: Eyota Summer Recreation Program). These were e-mailed out to everyone who provided an e-mail address, and can be found on cable channels HBC 19 and Charter 180.

Miscellaneous

- Register your child(ren) for the grade they just completed or their age on June 1, 2016.
- Ages 4-5 are considered Pre-school.
- A schedule or calendar will be provided for each participant on the first day of every activity, providing their schedule and the director's contact information.
- Each participant will receive a t-shirt to be handed out on the first day of all summer recreation activities. More t-shirt information on page 7 (Participation Agreement).
