



CITY OF EYOTA ANIMAL ORDINANCE CHANGES

Eyota City Council has approved a new Animal Ordinance – Ord. #151

Dogs and Cats:

Items remaining unchanged

- Rabies Certificate – dogs and cats are required to have current vaccinations by a licensed veterinarian, and have rabies vaccination certificates available upon request.
- Dogs & Cats need to wear vaccination and/or identification tags securely fastened to the animal's collar or harness
- Number of dogs and/or cats shall not exceed a total of 3 per household
- Animals at large (off the premises of the owner and not under restraint) will be fined and/or cited

Changes include

- Annual licensing requirement for dogs & cats has been eliminated



Chickens:

Items remaining unchanged

- Chickens must be permitted
- Chicken coops and runs must obtain a zoning permit and built to specific size limitations

Changes include

- Starting in 2017 permits will be valid for two years. (Jan 2017 – Dec 2018)
